MONTREAL DANCE COMPANY OFFERS CHANCE TO DANCE

October 20, 2009 - Montreal-based dance theatre company Trial & Eros Productions is holding a raffle to give aspiring and closet dancers the chance to create, develop and rehearse a solo piece with choreographer Deborah Dunn. It's a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to have a piece created specifically for you and your abilities as a dancer. It's every performer's, and closet performer's, dream."
